Bus tickets do not include entry to any of the landmarks, though. There's also a Big Bus Tours mobile app you can download so you can track in real-time when the next bus will arrive, and follow your route. TootBus also offers hop on hop off tours, in addition to thematic nonstop tours of Paris. The hop on hop off options visit the same sights as BigBus Tours, and run at the same cost as a ticket purchased on the street for BigBus Tours. The biggest difference between the two is that TootBus only offers audio guides in French and English, rather than a multitude of languages. TootBus does allow for free cancellation of your tickets, though. The night bus runs every day and departs at 8:15 pm and 9:15 pm. It costs € 32 (€ 26 for children under 12 and is free for children under 4). The buses leave from the Eiffel Tower and its itinerary is very similar to the Big Bus Paris one. The ticket price is € 35 for adults. For children aged 4 to 12 a ticket costs € 25, and for children under 4 the tour is free. Which tour bus to choose? All of the above companies offer very similar services, although we recommend Big Bus Paris, as it has more routes and more stops, and therefore offers a more complete tour.
