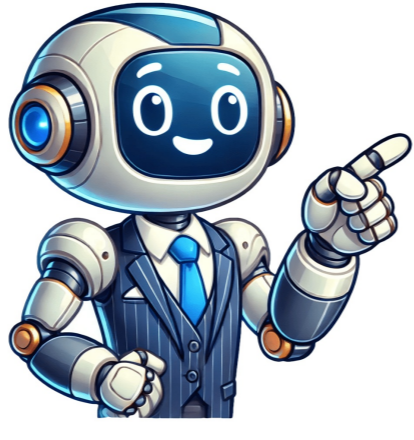

It is conveniently located about two minutes from 1-275 for residents of northwest Hamilton County. Mount Healthy Family Practice is what its name says - a close-knit family oriented community health center where neighbors visit with one another and physicians have treated patients for many years. Since this is a sliding fee scale clinic, we have provided the Federal Poverty Guidelines below. Persons In Family Household Poverty Guideline Salary per year 1 \$14,580 2 \$19,720 3 \$24,860 4 \$30,000 5 \$35,140 6 \$40,280 7 \$45,420 8 \$50,560 For Households with more than 8 persons, add \$4,480 for each additional person. *Alaska and Hawaii have different rates for HUD federal poverty guidelines. These numbers above represent 100% of the Federal Poverty Rate. In order to get reduced or free services from some clinics, they use a sliding fee scale based on your income. When they use a sliding fee scale, the 100% rate can be different than 100%. In those cases, using for example a 200% federal poverty level, you will only need double the 100% number listed above to 200%.
