Be aware of water safety and supervise children around pools or bodies of water to prevent drowning incidents. Learn to recognize the signs of drowning, which can occur even when someone is standing upright but in a panicked state. Wear protective gear such as helmets when riding ATVs, apply sunscreen frequently, stay hydrated by drinking plenty of fluids, and be cautious near open flames, grills, or water during the summer season.
