The NFA Main Campus is situated at 201 Fullerton Avenue in Newburgh. The campus offers numerous Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs, including the NECSD Marist Early College High School (ECHS) program, Teacher/Education (ECHS), Gaming (ECHS), Architectural/Engineering Design, Automotive, Barbering, Ceramics, Cosmetology, Culinary Arts, Fashion, Lifetime Wellness and Fitness, Performing Arts, Visual Arts, and Welding. These programs allow students to develop skills in areas such as residential and commercial structures, electronics, computer software, auto repair, hair and skin care, food presentation, sewing, drawing, textile design, sports management, and pottery. Additionally, the campus is home to AFJROTC, which aims to develop citizens of character dedicated to serving their nation and community through aerospace education, leadership management, and community involvement. NFA North Campus is located at 301 Robinson Avenue in Newburgh and offers programs such as AFJROTC, Criminal Justice, Health Related Services, and others. NFA North Campus offers a Nursing program pathway leading to CNA certification, while NFA P-TECH provides an Associates in Applied Science degree in Computer Information Technology. Students in both programs graduate with their high school diplomas and obtain skills for further studies or entry into the tech industry. At NFA P-TECH, students participate in project-based learning and collaborate with IBM on real-world projects. The program focuses on developing academic and career skills through authentic experiences and personalized learning plans. NFA West Campus prioritizes student self-esteem and offers a non-traditional educational experience that fosters genuine relationships between students and adults. Each scholar's program is designed by the people who know them best, with a focus on individual needs, interests, and passions. The campus also features the Learning Through Internships (LTI Program), which requires students to participate in an internship opportunity one day a week, building knowledge and understanding in authentic work settings. Additionally, NFA West Advisories aim to strengthen adult-student relationships and a sense of community among students through regular meetings with teachers and mentors. For informational purposes regarding academic, social, or future-planning concerns, each advisory group meets daily. NFA WEST students create a customized learning plan that aligns their course subjects with their desired career interests. Students will showcase their progress through an exhibition presentation for parents, advisors, mentors, and peers. Grades will be assigned for virtual learning, and academic progress will be monitored by teachers. Attendance is recorded based on students being in LIVE synchronous Google Classroom or watching asynchronous recorded videos and completing assignments. Students who cannot participate in the synchronous portion can watch recorded lessons and submit assignments by 11:59 p.m. to be marked present for the day. Grading will follow a 0-4 scale regardless of the learning model (virtual, in-person, or hybrid). Newburgh Free Academy is a high school serving over 2,500 students in grades 10-12. It offers various extracurricular activities like student organizations and sports teams, as well as guidance counseling programs. The football field is modern, but the campus can be confusing for visitors. The swim team's pool facilities are average, and some older buildings may appear outdated. It provides online tutoring services, disability support, and access to electronic databases. The college has degree programs in animation, graphic design, computer programming, and more. Additionally, it offers study courses in business, management, and technology.
