monastic communities. Along and beyond the Bulgarian border rise the Rodpi (Rhodope) Mountains, mainly composed of sharp-edged and sloping plateaus, reaching 7,260 feet (2,213 metres) at Mount rilos. The Maritsa River, in its low-lying, marshy valley, marks the Turkish border. From there to the lower Strymnas River extends a succession of plains, some of which are often swampy, such as the deltaic plain of the lower Nstos, and others have been turned into fertile agricultural land, as is the case in the former Lake Akhins. Inland there are basins of structural origin, such as the Plain of Drmas (Drama). Lakes Korneia (Kornia) and Vivi, which separate the Chalkidik Peninsula from the rest of the coastal region, also occupy structural depressions. Farther west, the large plain drained by the Vardaris and lower Alikmonos rivers is being continually extended as the river deltas push out into the Gulf of Thermaks (Thrmai). The forested Vrmion (Vrmio) Mountains and, beyond them, the barren inland basins around Lakes Vegortida (Vegorttis) and Kardsa mark the boundary with the Pndos Mountains.
