Morrison Academy is an international Christian school in Taiwan. It was established in 1952 to meet the educational needs of children of missionaries. From its earliest days, this missionary school has welcomed the children of other expatriates on a space available basis. Three Campuses Morrison Academy has three campuses: Taipei, Taichung, and Kaohsiung which serve students kindergarten through the twelfth grade. The Taichung campus is the only campus where boarding facilities are provided for high schoolers from areas outside of Taichung. In addition to its main campuses, Morrison has also operated several satellite schools in other areas of Taiwan for students through the sixth grade. Morrison also provides some services to missionaries in Taiwan who are home-schooling their children. Morrison Academy's Vision The vision of Morrison Academy is that each student will experience a quality, Biblically-integrated education. Morrison structures learning so that students may develop the knowledge, discernment, and ability to dynamically impact their world for Christ. A Christian International School Because Morrison is a Christian international school, a Biblical worldview is integrated into all areas of the American based curriculum. Bible class is required for all students. Instruction is in English and is college preparatory in focus. Advanced Placement credit is available for select courses. The school year for students extends from around the second Monday in August to the end of May or the first week of June, for a total of 180 instructional days. The school is jointly accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International and the Western Association of Schools and Colleges. The school's boarding program is also accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International. An International Christian School Morrison Academy is recognized by Taiwan as an international school and is restricted from accepting nationals who do not hold a foreign passport. The majority of our students, approximately 60%, are citizens of the United States. The remainder of our students come from many other countries. It primarily caters to the children of missionaries.[1] Beyond the original Taichung location it also maintains a campus in Taipei and Morrison Academy Kaohsiung in Kaohsiung; other satellite campuses have existed in the past. Morrison Academy was named after Robert Morrison, the first Protestant missionary to China.[2] The school states that it teaches from a "Christian perspective" and uses an "American-based" curriculum. The medium of instruction is English.[3] Morrison Academy's approach to education integrates "Biblical truth with educational knowledge".[4] The academy teaches a Bible curriculum[5] other subject areas, including science and social studies, are taught to be used from a Christian perspective.[6][7] Morrison Academy teaches Earth Science, Life Science, Physical Science, and Engineering and Design in elementary middle school.[8] In high school, the scope and sequence are Biology, Chemistry, Human Anatomy, Physical Science, Physics, AP Biology, and AP Chemistry. Morrison Academy has a "Biblical worldview".[8][9] The school's science curriculum guide states that, "Morrison Academy insists that God made the universe... Science, as exemplified in the scientific method, is a process that enables all mankind to gain knowledge about creation, the laws that govern it, and the character of God."[8] Morrison Academy actively promotes the biblical belief that marriage is "the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union" as per Genesis 2:18-25 and that sexual intimacy is "only between a man and a woman who are married to each other" as per Matthew 19:4-6. "Actively engaged" describes Morrison high school students. Rigorous courses, leadership opportunities, sports, drama, worship team, mission trips, and class activities all provide opportunities for students to take the knowledge they've learned and apply it with ever-increasing wisdom. In January 2013, the Board authorized that Grades 10-12 be added to the Kaohsiung and Taipei campus. By providing high school in the southern and northern campuses, this gives parents the option of having their child(ren) stay at home during their high school years. The Taichung campus is a 180-student high school. The Taipei and Kaohsiung campuses are each 100-student high schools. In addition to academic programs, a wide range of extracurricular programs in sports, music, drama and other areas are offered. Operated by four Christian mission groups, the school stresses Christian values among students and teachers. Welcome to Morrison Academy Taichung Campus! Located in Taichung's Beitun District, Morrison Academy Central occupies a spacious 22.5 acres. Our picturesque campus is beautiful and peaceful. Taichung offers classes from kindergarten through twelfth grade and has a quality boarding program that provides a home-like atmosphere. In order to enhance our learning environment, the school has a modern Library, Visual and Performing Arts Facility, Robotics Lab, Art and Pottery Studio and Cafeteria. Our library has approximately 32,500 print volumes, including a substantial Chinese language selection, and through Morrison's interlibrary loan service students have access to an additional 60,000 volumes at their fingertips and thousands more through our quality online databases. Promoting a climate of innovation, the library is home to a Makerspace. In our Robotics Lab, students of all ages enjoy learning, experimenting, creating and coding. The Visual and Performing Arts Facility has a full stage and seating for 300 people. Our Art and Pottery Studio is equipped with 2 kilns, a slab maker, a pug mill and several pottery wheels. Our on-site cafeteria provides a nutritious diet, including 2 entrees; one Western, one Asian each day. With fresh fruit and vegetables, our students are blessed with delicious and healthy choices for every lunch. Our outdoor athletic facilities include a full-size track and sports field, an aquatic center, outdoor basketball court, a covered play area, and 2 grass practice fields. Our indoor athletic facilities include a lower and upper gymnasium, a weight room, and a 3rd-floor cardio room with exercise class space. Recently remodeled, our indoor facilities now include 2 Varsity team rooms, locker rooms & showers, an athletic training room, and a physical education classroom. Educating the whole child is one of our core values. We believe that these updated facilities encourage not only health and wellness, but also provide the facilities necessary to develop our lifeguarding program and first aid club.
