The cost of a vehicle inspection in Virginia is \$16.00 for motor vehicles and recreation vehicles, plus trailers (including semi-trailers). Motorcycles cost \$12.00, while tractor-trailers, trucks with a GVW of 26,000 pounds or more, or passenger vehicles with seating capacity over 15 passengers including the driver, cost \$51.00. State Police will increase patrols with focus on July 3 and July 6, which are expected to be the busiest travel days. In 2024, Virginia troopers arrested 95 drivers for operating under influence, cited 4,044 speeders, 1,868 reckless drivers, issued 574 citations for not wearing seatbelts, and another 191 citations for children not properly secured in vehicles.
