As of Dec 13, 2023, the average annual pay for a Panda Cuddler in the United States is \$54,962 a year. For \$32,000 per year, panda cuddlers spend every waking hour hugging and playing with pandas. The hours may seem long, and the lack of days off may cause some fatigue, but can this be considered work? Panda cuddlers are living out every ten-year-olds dream. People love pandas for their clumsy, playful and lazy behaviour. Did you know that there's an actual job that involves cuddling pandas and taking care of them all day? Yes, it's true. Panda preservation facilities actually employ people for hugging and playing with these adorable animals for hours. You must be licensed by either the China Conservation and Research Center for the Giant Panda or the Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) to work with pandas. Passing a written exam and proving your proficiency in panda biology, behavior, and care are prerequisites for certification. Not only do panda nannies get to hang out with the adorable bears all day, they also get \$32,000 per year, plus room, board, and even a company car. The job requirements are: writing and photography skills, as well as "some basic knowledge of pandas," per China Daily. You only get to sit with the panda for about 30 seconds but it's the only place in the world that allows tourists to do it and it is worth every second. Make sure you book in advance and be aware it is 300 USD per person. While pandas are regarded as cuddly, quiet animals, they certainly have a dangerous side when they feel threatened. They're solitary creatures and like to avoid confrontation, the World Wildlife Fund reports, but have sharp claws and teeth and may attack to protect themselves or their cubs if provoked. First of all, although they are undeniably cute and cuddly-looking, you wouldn't want to get too close. "Giant pandas' teeth, claws, fleas, ticks and mites mean you probably don't want to give them a hug," according to Steven Price, Canada's senior conservation director at the World Wildlife Fund. Hugging a panda is not recommended, as it could be stressful for the animal and potentially dangerous for the person attempting the hug. It's best to admire pandas from a safe distance and support conservation efforts to protect their natural habitat. About 1,850 giant pandas (*Ailuropoda melanoleuca*) are alive in the wild, and about 300 live in captivity. However, only three panda bases in China accept volunteers. Bifengxia. You also have to be over age 22, have writing skills and the ability to take photos, and know a lot about pandas. Be warned, it is not cheap to hold a panda. The prices are constantly rising, but expect to spend at least \$320 USD. The best way to rationalize the cost is to think of it as a "donation". The funds help preserve these animals that had been on the endangered species list for over a decade. Pandas are intelligent animals with complex behaviour and a good memory. Their cognitive ability is comparable to that of chimpanzees and gorillas. However, their intelligence is often underestimated due to their slow-moving demeanour. Make sure you arrange with Dujiangyan Panda Base and Center for Disease Control to get the full experience. A fully grown panda is far too formidable a foe for most predators, but some animals can prey on cubs. Potential predators include jackals, snow leopards and yellow-throated martens, all of which are capable of killing and eating panda cubs. Pandas eat almost nothing but bamboo shoots and leaves. Occasionally they eat other vegetation, fish, or small mammals, but bamboo accounts for 99 percent of their diets. Pandas eat fast, they eat a lot, and they spend about 12 hours a day doing it. Most pandas leave their mothers when she becomes pregnant again, usually at about 18 months. A panda's average life span in the wild is 14-20 years. But they can live up to 30 years in captivity. Half of all panda births result in twins, however, it is very rare for both cubs to survive as giant pandas almost always abandon a cub if they give birth to more than one. The reason is that they don't have sufficient milk or energy to care for two so focus their attentions on the strongest cub. They estimate that lifespan is about 15-20 years for wild pandas and about 30 years for those in human care. Chinese scientists have reported zoo pandas as old as 35. Mei Yan has been working at the Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding since 2008. The bespectacled woman has become one of the most experienced members of staff there.
