## How to chunk mine in minecraft

To get borders around chunks in Minecraft, follow this step-by-step guide. For Java Edition on PC, press "F3" + "G" to see chunk borders instantly. On Bedrock Edition for Xbox, PlayStation, or mobile devices, go to Settings > Game > toggle on Show Coordinates. For Java Edition: 1. Launch your world and press F3+G. 2. Chunk borders will appear as a multicolored wireframe border around the current chunk you're standing in. 3. To turn off borders, press F3 + G again. For Bedrock Edition: 1. Launch your world. 2. Open Settings by pressing ESC (if using a keyboard) or Start (if using a controller). 3. Click Game under the World header on the left side. 4. Toggle on Show Coordinates under the World Options header. 5. Determine your location by checking if either of the X or Z coordinates are divisible by 16. 6. If both X and Z coordinates are divisible by 16, you're in the northwest corner of the chunk.
