PTC Creo was initially released in 1987 as Pro/Engineer and later rebranded as Creo in 2011. This software is a multifaceted 3D CAD tool that includes various design tools for computer-aided design, engineering, and manufacturing. With Creo, users can experience smooth product design through its parametric features, simulations, analyses, and CAM capabilities all integrated within one platform. Although mastering Creo's design process isn't extremely challenging, creating a project from scratch can be quite time-consuming. Fortunately, there are thousands of models available for download that can be used directly or customized to fit specific needs. These models significantly reduce the design time for professionals while providing beginners with useful reference points during their learning phase. While many models are accessible through paid websites, there's also a considerable amount of free Creo models out there. This article will explore 13 websites where users can download free Creo models, keeping in mind that these sites are not ranked or compared.

PTC PARTcommunity** - This online CAD solution offers various industry professionals, including architects, designers, engineers, and technicians, a platform to access standard user and supplier-contributed 2D and 3D CAD models in Creo file formats (.prt and .asm). The site's interface is well-organized with an easy-to-use search bar at the top. Users can filter their searches through various intelligent options such as sketch, solidity, color, certified catalog, supplier, and categories.
- 2. CGTrader** - With over a million members, this virtual 3D content marketplace offers model marketplaces, CAD tutorials, and freelance job opportunities. The site's models are categorized into diverse categories like aircraft, animals, architecture, vehicles, plants, etc., with thousands of free models available for download. Users must register to begin downloading.
- 3. Archive 3D** - This platform provides 3D models specifically tailored for graphic design and animation needs. Its straightforward interface features a Google custom search bar and model categories on the home screen. The models are categorized into various fields like furnishing, equipment, structures, etc., without requiring user registration to start downloading.
- 4. Turbosquid** - This site offers an extensive range of models, although most are premium (paid). However, users can find approximately 30,000 free models from various software, including Creo. The search option on the home page or through well-outlined categories makes finding models seamless.
- 1. GrabCAD** - A Large Online CAD Community GrabCAD offers a large library with over four million-plus free CAD files, including PTC native formats, to its members. Members can use the search bar or browse through categories to find their desired models. Registration is mandatory.
- 2. 3D Content Central** - A Huge Online Service Provider With over two million CAD users, 3D Content Central offers user and supplier-contributed free models for download. Its library has thousands of models compatible with popular CAD programs like Creo. Members can search or request a model designed by professionals.
- 3. TraceParts** - A Leading Online Provider TraceParts provides digital marketing services and has over 100 million CAD models, all free of charge. Members can search through manufacturer catalogs or sectors like civil engineering and mechanical engineering.
- 4. 3D CAD Browser** - A Site Dedicated to 3D Models Though mostly paid, 3D CAD Browser offers around a thousand free models in various formats. Registration is required for downloading, and uploading a model helps increase the library's number of models.
- 5. Cad Crowd** - An All-in-One Online Service Provider Cad Crowd offers modeling and rendering services, freelance design, 3D models, and design contests. Its library features thousands of free models in different file formats. Members can search or sort by categories using a search bar.
- 6. MorphoSource** - An Online Platform for Researchers MorphoSource was created by anthropologists to share 3D designs. With over 15,000+ free models available, it's mainly used by researchers searching for anthropology-related 3D designs.
